**Please forward to Gholamhossein Mohseni Ejei, Head of judiciary**

Dear Mr Gholamhossein Mohseni Ejei,

For three months, Swedish-Iranian academic and medical doctor **Ahmadreza Djalali**, arbitrarily detained in Iran since April 2016 and sentenced to death following a grossly unfair trial, was being subjected to enforced disappearance, a crime under international law. From 24 June until 24 September 2025, Iranian authorities denied his family and lawyers information about his fate and whereabouts despite their repeated efforts to obtain information.

Dr Djalali continues to be at grave risk of execution amid the ongoing crisis. Throughout 2025, Ahmadreza Djalali's health deteriorated further, including following a heart attack in early May 2025, while authorities denied him access to adequate healthcare, further heightening fears for his health and life while forcibly disappeared. In October 2017, a Revolutionary Court sentenced Ahmadreza Djalali to death for "corruption on earth" (efsad-e fel-arz) after a grossly unfair trial on unsubstantiated allegations of collaborating and communicating with Israel, which he has repeatedly denied. Ahmadreza Djalali's detention is arbitrary due to the gravity of the violations of his fair trial rights, including to the presumption of innocence; to not self-incriminate; to a trial before an independent, competent and impartial tribunal; to access a lawyer from the time of arrest; to an adequate defence; to be protected from torture and other ill-treatment and to meaningfully challenge the legality of his detention.

**I call on you to immediately halt any plans to execute Ahmadreza Djalali, quash his conviction and death sentence, and immediately release him as his detention is rendered arbitrary due to the severe non-observance of his fair trial rights. Pending release, he must be provided prompt and ongoing access to his family, lawyers, adequate medical care and protected from further torture and other ill-treatment. Prompt, independent, effective and impartial investigations into those suspected of ordering, committing, aiding or abetting unlawful acts must be conducted and suspects of such offences brought to justice in fair trials. An official moratorium on executions must also be established with a view to abolishing the death penalty.**
