Dear Mr. Gabitashvili,

I am writing to express grave concern regarding the allegations of torture and other ill-treatment of activist **Saba Skhvitaridze**, who was arrested on 5 December 2024 after participating in an anti-government protest. He was beaten by police officers and denied access to legal counsel and medical care. On 2 and 3 September 2025, in two separate proceedings, a court in Tbilisi sentenced Saba and several other individuals to prison terms for alleged public order disturbance. Saba was also sentenced on 3 September for causing minor bodily harm to an officer.

His arrest and trial have been marred with violations of fair trial guarantees. Police officers confiscated both Saba's and his father's mobile phones to prevent him from contacting his lawyer and he was interrogated without his lawyer being present. His whereabouts were only disclosed to his family and lawyer following his interrogation, five hours later. Saba reported that, while in custody, he was threatened with rape and forced to sign a "confession" stating he assaulted a police officer. When he refused, masked officers beat him violently. Police officers then mocked him and ignored his plea for access to a lawyer and medical assistance.

Despite the visible injuries that Saba displayed at the pre-trial hearing the following day, the authorities only initiated an investigation days later after an independent medical examination confirmed that his injuries were consistent with torture. Nevertheless, the judge ordered him to be remanded in detention pending trial without providing any justification for the necessity and proportionality of his decision.

Saba Skhvitaridze is one of hundreds of people in Georgia who have been tortured or otherwise ill-treated by law enforcement officials during peaceful protests. He remains held at a high security prison, his allegations of torture and other ill-treatment have not been effectively investigated.

I urge you to ensure a prompt, impartial, independent and effective investigation into the allegations of torture and other ill-treatment of Saba Skhvitaridze and to bring all those responsible to justice in fair trials. I also call on you to quash these unfair convictions and release or give fair retrials, including fair bail hearings, to Saba Skhvitaridze and the others. All those detained solely for the exercise of their rights to freedom of peaceful assembly and expression must be immediately released.
